- **Objective**: The purpose of South Bay Junior Academy's service trip to Washington D.C. is to awaken a passion to live a life of service, to wrestle with how we are called to make a difference in this world as followers of Christ, and to develop a desire to learn.
- **Description**: For the first week of the trip, we will be working with City Service Missions (a.k.a. Center for Student Missions) to serve the homeless and poor of our nation's capital.
